

### **CITRUS COUNTY MOSQUITO CONTROL DISTRICT**

### **MAJOR FUNCTION**

Performs supervisory and technical duties involving the dispersion of insecticides, larvicides, and herbicides utilized in mosquito and noxious weed control operations.

### **DISTINGUISHING FEATURES**

Employees in this class perform duties of average difficulty requiring reasonable initiative and independent judgment under general supervision.

### **MAJOR DUTIES**

Note: The following duties are illustrative and not exhaustive. The omission of specific statements of duties does not exclude them from the position if the work is similar, related, or a logical assignment to the position. Depending on assigned area of responsibility, incumbents in the position may perform some or all of the activities described below.

- Supervises the work of subordinate staff by scheduling, assigning and reviewing work, providing training and guidance, and evaluating performance.
- Schedules and supervises the mosquito and aquatic weed control operations.
- Supervises the operation and repair of all mechanical equipment used in mosquito and weed control.
- Inspects equipment for adherence to safety standards.
- Maintains inventory records to include requisitions for supplies and equipment.
- May apply pesticides during times of increased arthropod activity.
- Performs other related duties as required.

## **KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, & ABILITIES**

- Considerable knowledge of mosquito and weed control methods, materials and equipment.
- Working knowledge of larviciding and fogging equipment operation and

maintenance.

- Skill in the operation of assigned equipment.
- Ability to work effectively with others.
- Ability to plan, organize, and supervise the work of others.
- Ability to prepare written activity reports.

# **RECOMMENDED MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS**

Graduation from high school or possession of a GED Certificate; and Three years of experience in mosquito and noxious weed control operations, and Possession of a current State of Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services Restricted Pesticide Use License in Aquatic Weed Control, Right of Way, and A current State of Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services Public Health Pest Control Certification; and A valid Driver License.

Citrus County Mosquito Control District is a drug free work place and will require a pre-employment drug screening.
