# MAJOR DUTIES

- Lead the surveillance dept. in the monitoring of mosquito populations
- Improve understanding of mosquito breeding habitats and resources
- Lead Arbovirus monitoring program
- Lead trapping program, collections, and identifications
- Monitors the efficacy of products and treatment techniques.
- Coordinate research efforts with state universities, private industry, and government agencies.
- Works with industry partners in product and application method testing
- Calibrates spray equipment and analyzes results.
- Leads resistance testing program for local mosquito population
- Compile data, prepare reports and present findings
- May apply pesticides during times of increased arthropod activity.
- Performs other related duties as required.
- Performs all responsibilities of Surveillance dept, and staff

- Considerable knowledge in arboviruses, vectors and transmission cycles
