#### **MAJOR FUNCTION**

Oversees ULV operations

#### **DISTINGUISHING FEATURES**

Employees in this class perform duties of above average difficulty requiring initiative and independent judgment under general supervision.

#### **MAJOR DUTIES**

Note: The following duties are illustrative and not exhaustive. The omission of specific statements of duties does not exclude them from the position if the work is similar, related, or a logical assignment to the position. Depending on assigned area of responsibility, incumbents in the position may perform some or all of the activities described below.

- Supervises the seasonal and full time ULV applicators.
- Trains new drivers on proper ULV vehicle operations and district policies and procedures.
- Follows all federal and state laws and district policies regarding health and safety.
- Performs inspection of vehicle and ULV equipment nightly prior to use.
- Utilizes computer software to complete assignments.
- Applies chemical ULV accurately and in a safe, proper, and timely manner.
- Contacts residents from call list as required.
- Troubleshoots any problems.
- Secures facility at night.
- Provides technical assistance to subordinates.
- Performs tasks related to mosquito control while on day shift during off season.
- Performs other related duties as required.

#### **KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, & ABILITIES**

- Ability to perform all duties required of the ULV Coordinator.
- Working knowledge of fogging equipment.
- Skill in the operation, and maintenance of spray equipment.
- Ability to work effectively with others.
- Ability to plan, organize, and supervise the work of others.
- Ability to prepare written activity reports.
- Good working knowledge of computer programs.

## JOB DESCRIPTION

### **RECOMMENDED MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS**

- Graduation from high school or possession of a GED Certificate.
- Three years of experience in mosquito control, including spray operations, inspections and treatments.
- At least 2 years of satisfactory (At or Above expectation) performance evaluations.
- A current State of Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services Public Health Pest Control Certification.
- Possession of a valid Driver License.
